**Builders Club-** Fontainebleau Junior High Builders Club is a Co-educational service organization that provides 8th grade students the opportunity to help others, serve their school and community and to build a positive future for themselves.

**Canes C.R.E.W-** The Canes C.R.E.W is a group that encourages kindness and compassion towards others through various school wide activities.
